Johnson County Montessori Preschool is open 7am to 6pm Monday through Friday.

Montessori Preschool + Full Day Care

for ages 2 1/2, 4 and 5. Typical schedule includes supervised play for those who arrive early (between 7 and 8:30am). Montessori learning time from 8:30 to 11:30am, lunch, rest period, and planned activities in the afternoon (until 6pm).

Montessori Preschool only for ages 2 1/2, 4 and 5, 8:30 to 11:30am (does not include lunch)

Kindergarten + Full Day Care

for children who are age 5 on or before August 31. Our kindergarten program blends Montessori philosophy and materials with those of the traditional kindergarten, with emphasis on math and reading readiness. Typical schedule includes supervised play for those who arrive between 7 and 8:30am, lunch, rest period and planned activities in the afternoon (until 6pm) five days per week.

Kindergarten only

for children who are age 5 on or before August 31st, 8:30 to 11:30am (does not include lunch). Five days per week.

Music Program

consists of a 30-minute segment each week that includes singing, rhythm, instruments, creative movement, and music appreciation, taught by a certified music teacher.
